Explore the many ways you can be creative just by stepping outside your own front door...



You don't need paint to be an artist, simply use water and a brush on a sunny day to create pictures and patterns on bricks, concrete or even garden furniture.



Gather small objects from around the house, arrange on a piece of paper and draw the shadows they cast. Move them around to create repeat patterns and overlapping lines.



Collect sticks and leaves from your garden or daily walk to use as brushes, and explore mark-making using mud as your paint.



No garden? Why not explore the different textures and patterns outside your home and create artwork by making rubbings using a wax crayon or pencil.
